None other is so loving, so good and kind.

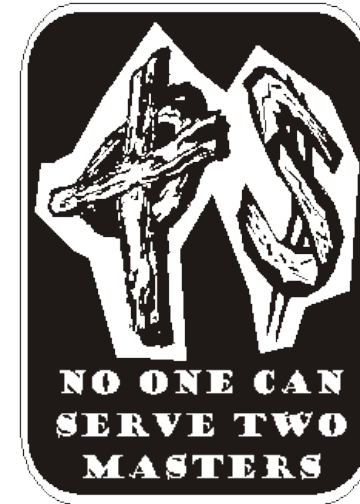
